Award Categories & Construction-Related Selection Criteria

1. Biodiversity Award

Recognizes construction projects or organizations that actively protect and enhance biodiversity within project sites.

Criteria:

- Use of eco-sensitive designs minimizing impact on flora and fauna
- Restoration of natural habitats post-construction
- Integration of green spaces and native vegetation in urban developments

2. Energy Transition Award

Honors efforts to shift construction practices or infrastructure to renewable and low-carbon energy sources.

Criteria:

- Use of renewable energy systems in construction projects
- Reduction of fossil fuel dependence in building operations
- Net-zero energy building implementations

3. Future Leader Award

Presented to young professionals or students making significant contributions to sustainable construction.

Criteria:

- Demonstrated leadership in green construction projects
- Research or innovations in sustainable building technologies
- Active involvement in construction-focused sustainability initiatives

4. NGO Award

Recognizes NGOs contributing to sustainable development within the construction industry.

Criteria:

- Advocacy for green building codes and practices
- Grassroots campaigns promoting sustainable construction
- Community-based housing or eco-village projects

5. Best AI in Education Award

For institutions using AI to advance sustainable construction education.

Criteria:

- AI-driven training tools in green engineering or architecture
- Integration of AI in sustainability research
- Impact on student outcomes in the construction field

6. Sustainable Insurance Award

Recognizes insurance providers promoting sustainability in construction through innovative products.

Criteria:

- Insurance coverage tailored for green building projects
- Incentives for risk mitigation through sustainable design
- Support for climate-resilient construction

7. Sustainability Business Leader of the Year Award

Acknowledges an executive championing sustainability within the construction sector.

Criteria:

- Leadership in integrating ESG principles into construction business operations
- Influence on industry standards and sustainable practices
- Proven impact on carbon reduction and resource efficiency

8. Sustainable Technology Provider Award

For companies delivering technologies that improve sustainability in construction.

Criteria:

- Innovation in green building materials or smart construction solutions
- Proven environmental benefits and scalability
- Industry adoption within construction projects

9. Sustainable Finance Provider Award

For institutions supporting sustainable construction through finance.

Criteria:

- Green construction loans or financial products
- Funding projects with measurable environmental performance
- Integration of sustainability metrics in investment decisions

10. Sustainable Telecommunication Provider Award

Recognizes telecom firms enabling digital solutions for green construction.

Criteria:

- Smart site monitoring tools that reduce emissions/waste
- Eco-friendly infrastructure development within construction projects
- Support for remote management and reduced travel emissions

11. Sustainable Event Management Company Award

Acknowledges firms hosting sustainable construction-related events.

Criteria:

- Use of eco-conscious materials and logistics
- Minimal environmental footprint of construction expos/workshops
- Education and awareness on green construction

12. Sustainable Logistic Provider Award

For logistics providers enabling greener construction supply chains.

Criteria:

- Use of electric/hybrid vehicles in material delivery
- Efficient route planning and packaging waste reduction
- Climate-conscious warehousing for construction materials

13. Sustainable Innovation Award

Honors breakthrough innovations advancing sustainable construction.

Criteria:

- New products, processes, or business models
- Measurable improvements in environmental performance
- Relevance and adoption within the construction sector

14. Sustainable Cyber Security Award

Recognizes organizations or technologies enhancing cybersecurity in sustainable construction systems.

Criteria:

- Implementation of secure digital platforms in smart construction projects
- Cyber resilience in Building Information Modeling (BIM) and IoT applications
- Data protection in sustainability-focused construction management tools
- Contribution to secure, remote, and paperless construction processes

15. Sustainable Health & Safety Award

Honors construction entities ensuring worker well-being and environmental safety through sustainable practices.

Criteria:

- Adoption of green health & safety protocols (low-toxicity materials, dust & noise control)
- Investment in training and safe work environments in line with sustainability goals
- Integration of wellness design features into construction (natural lighting, ventilation)
- Reduced accident rates through technology and eco-conscious site planning

16. Sustainable Hotel Award

Acknowledges hospitality developments showcasing sustainable construction.

Criteria:

- Green building certifications by a competent institute (e.g., LEED, CIOB)
- Energy and water efficiency in hotel operations
- Sustainable material sourcing and waste management

17. Sustainable Salon Award

Recognizes salon establishments in sustainably constructed buildings.

Criteria:

- Low-impact construction or renovations
- Use of non-toxic building materials
- Management of toxic waste
- Energy-efficient HVAC and lighting in design

18. Sustainable Brand of the Year Award

For brands in the construction supply chain committed to sustainability.

Criteria:

- Sustainable product lines
- Eco-conscious branding practices
- Public engagement on sustainable construction

19. Sustainable University Award

Recognizes universities or degree awarding institutes promoting sustainable construction education and infrastructure.

Criteria:

- Green campus initiatives and sustainable building projects
- Curriculum focused on sustainable engineering / architecture / construction-related disciplines
- Research outputs linked to construction industry challenges

20. Sustainable Institute Award

For institutions advancing sustainable building knowledge.

Criteria:

- Professional development in green building techniques
- Industry partnerships on sustainability research
- Construction-related sustainability awards or recognitions

21. Sustainable Embassy Award

For embassies located in green buildings or promoting sustainability in construction.

Criteria:

- Leadership in showcasing sustainable diplomatic missions
- Hosting green construction-related programs or events
- Compliance with sustainable building codes

22. Sustainable Mobile App Award

Recognizes mobile apps aiding sustainable construction efforts.

Criteria:

- Monitoring carbon footprints or energy use on-site
- Facilitating green project management or supply chain tracking
- User impact and engagement within the construction industry

23. Sustainable Eco Design Award

For outstanding sustainable design concepts in construction.

Criteria:

- Passive design principles and bioclimatic architecture
- Integration of circular design concepts
- Innovation in material use and site efficiency

24. Sustainable Communications Campaign Award

Honors campaigns raising awareness about sustainable construction.

Criteria:

- Messaging effectiveness and public reach
- Visual content promoting sustainable practices in building
- Industry collaboration

25. Sustainable Magazine Award

For publications promoting sustainability in construction.

Criteria:

- Regular coverage of green projects and innovations
- Thought leadership in sustainable development
- Educational impact on construction professionals

26. Sustainable Media Network Award

Acknowledges media platforms advocating sustainability in the construction sector.

Criteria:

- Consistent dissemination of green construction content
- Multi-channel engagement (TV, social, print)
- Partnerships with sustainable building bodies

27. Sustainable Construction Project Award

Recognizes exemplary construction projects demonstrating comprehensive sustainability.

Criteria:

- Use of sustainable materials and energy systems
- Site management and waste reduction practices
- Long-term environmental and social benefits

28. Sustainable Construction for Youth Empowerment Award

Recognizes projects or organizations using sustainable construction to uplift youth communities.

Criteria:

- Training or employment of youth in green building initiatives
- Youth-led or youth-engaged sustainable construction projects
- Partnerships with vocational or educational institutions on sustainable construction
- Demonstrable impact on youth capacity-building in eco-construction practices

Criteria:

- Integration of local communities and sustainable livelihoods into the tourism construction value chain
- Contribution to Sri Lanka's eco-tourism objectives through green infrastructure

30. Sustainable Organization Award

For organizations embedding sustainability across any construction operation.
